

Mantus M1 vs. M2 Anchors – Which Is Better?

After the release of the Mantus M2 Model we, at Mantus, often get the question – which one is better?

Both Anchors have an amazing setting and resetting ability, and both are excellent choices for a primary anchor, but each has its own minor specific advantages.

Both anchors roll over well in most bottom conditions and it is rare for a properly weighted anchor to end up upside down, nevertheless, the M1 Anchor due to its roll bar is better at rolling over in an extremely soft silty bottom.

The M2 anchor is less likely to get plugged up with muddy weeds, and without the need for the roll bar the M2 is less bulky. Thus, the M2 model provides a better fit for boats with bow pulpits with slotted anchor housings and bow sprits.
